- 4th year of Negative Factor / Rescission:
 - FY09-10 \$130M, FY10-11 \$381M, FY11-12 \$774M, **FY12-13 \$1.001B**
- Mill Levy Override dollars increased \$304.4M between 07-08 and 12-13
 - 12-13: \$806.8M generated by 115 districts; 18 districts generated 85.6% (\$692.5M), remaining 97 districts 14.4%, 63 districts no MLO
- Increased per pupil spending \$79 from 2011-12;
 - adjusted for inflation: \$305 less per pupil than 07-08.

Highlights for 2012-13 (cont.)

- As annual funded pupil count continues to increase (9,500+); the number of teachers per student decreasing.
 - 63 teachers/1,000 students in 07-08,
 - 60 teachers/1,000 students in 12-13.
- Average Teacher Salary in 2012-13: \$7K less than National Average
 - Adjusted for inflation: CO teachers made \$8,400
 less than CO teacher in 92-93. (14.6% decrease)
