

Need Factors

The following table presents the need factor information for each district in the state. A need factor represents the average level of student need for a district. To calculate the need factor the weights derived for special education, at-risk, and ELL students in the 2013 Colorado Adequacy study are used. The weights are 1.0 for special education students, .35 for at-risk students, and .47 for ELL students. A district’s need factor is calculated by multiplying the special education, free and reduced price lunch counts (different than just the free lunch count used by Colorado), and ELL counts from the 2015-16 membership information available from the Colorado Department of Education. These figures are multiplied by the weights for each category and adding the weighted students to the funded pupil count of the district and then dividing by the funded pupil count. An example is shown below.

District A: $(5,000 \text{ FPC} + (60 \text{ special education students} \times 1.0) + (200 \text{ free or reduced price lunch students} \times .35) + (30 \text{ ELL students} \times .47)) / 500 \text{ FPC} = 1.29 \text{ need factor}$

A district with no special needs students would have a need factor of 1.0. A district like the example district A has a student population with need that is 29 percent higher than a district with no special needs students. The column titled “Need Factor for Sped, ELL, and FRL” shows the calculated need factor for each district. The bottom of the table shows the descriptive statistics for the state. The mean need factor for the state is 1.33, meaning the average district has need that is 33 percent above a district with no special needs. The median is slightly lower at 1.32. The overall range is from a low of 1.12 to a high of 1.68.

In Colorado, a number of other factors are taken into consideration as part of funding including cost-of-living and size. For this analysis, the size factor was also examined. The second column labeled “Need and Size” creates a district factor utilizing the need factor and the size adjustment factor from the adequacy study. The mean of this factor is 1.92 with a median of 1.79. The range is from 1.17 to 2.95.

Tax Effort and Fiscal Capacity

The data below shows various tax effort and capacity information for each district in the state. The per student figures are calculated using the funded pupil counts without Charter School Institute students.

The tax effort information includes the Total Program Mills, Bond Mills, Total Override Mills, and Total Mills. Total Program Mills is the number of mills each district levies as part of the school finance act.

- Districts average 19.72 Total Program Mills with a median of 21.74 mills and a range from 1.68 to 27 mills.
- Bond Mills range from 0 to 22.07 mills with a mean of 6.06 and a median of 5.34.
- Total Override Mills have an average of 4.06, a median of 2.29, and a range from 0 to 22.47 mills.
- Total Mills range from 5.85 to 66.65 mills with a mean of 30.13 and a median of 29.22 mills.

The last two columns look at each districts fiscal capacity. The fiscal capacity is the amount of dollars each mill can raise against the assessed value of the district.

- The “Amount Raised by 1 Mill” column examines how much a district can raise levying one mill against assessed value. The average amount raised is \$578,590 with a median of \$111,054 and a range from \$3,842 to \$13,221,694.
- The second column, “Amount Raise per Student for 1 Mill”, looks at the amount raised per funded pupil count. The range is from \$19 to \$3,239 per student with an average of \$283 and a median of \$133.
