Summary:

1. Salaries remain 11.1 percentage points behind the national average growth over the last 17 years (not adjusted for inflation).
2. Adjusted for inflation, Colorado's average teacher salaries are over \$4,000 less than they were in 1992-93.
3. Over the same 17 year time period, adjusted for inflation, the national average for teacher salaries has increased 3.1%.
