More Students

Almost 9,000 more funded pupils between 2014-15 and 2015-16.  
(Between 2013-14 & 2014-15 funded pupil increased 14,000 pupils.)

Fewer Dollars: Per Pupil Spending

\$520 (-5.1%) less per student between 2010-11 and 2015-16.  
(adjusting for inflation)

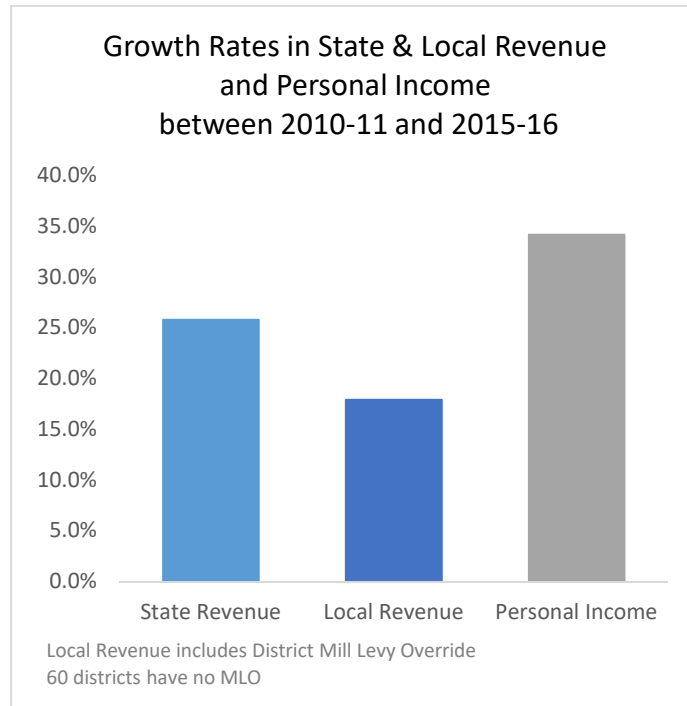
No change: Per Pupil Revenues

Remained approximately the same between 2010-11 and 2015-16.  
(adjusting for inflation)

Average Colorado Teacher Salary

- Average CO teacher salary:
  - Increased \$2,100 between 2010-11 & 2015-16.
  - Adjusting for inflation: \$4,300 (-7.7%) below 2010-11.
- Average CO teacher salary is \$7,000 below the national average.

## 2017 State Profile Data - Highlights (2015-16 audited data)



Colorado’s share of personal income used for K-12 education declined over 0.5% from 2010-11 to 2015-16.

At the 2010-11 rate, an additional \$988.7 million could have been raised for K-12.
