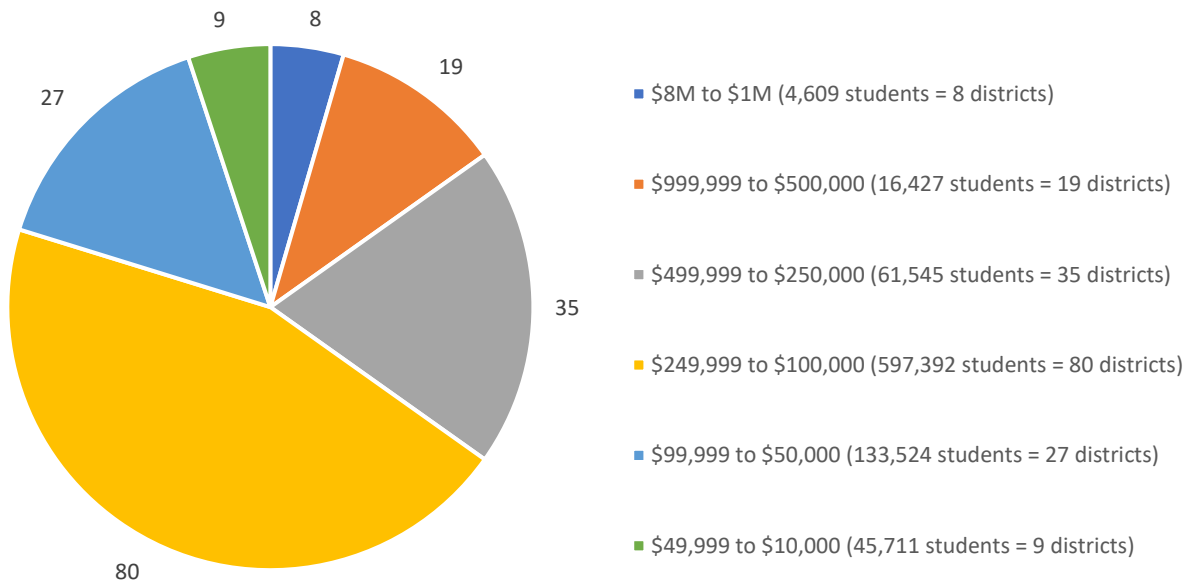


School Districts' Assessed Value Per Pupil FY 2022-23
