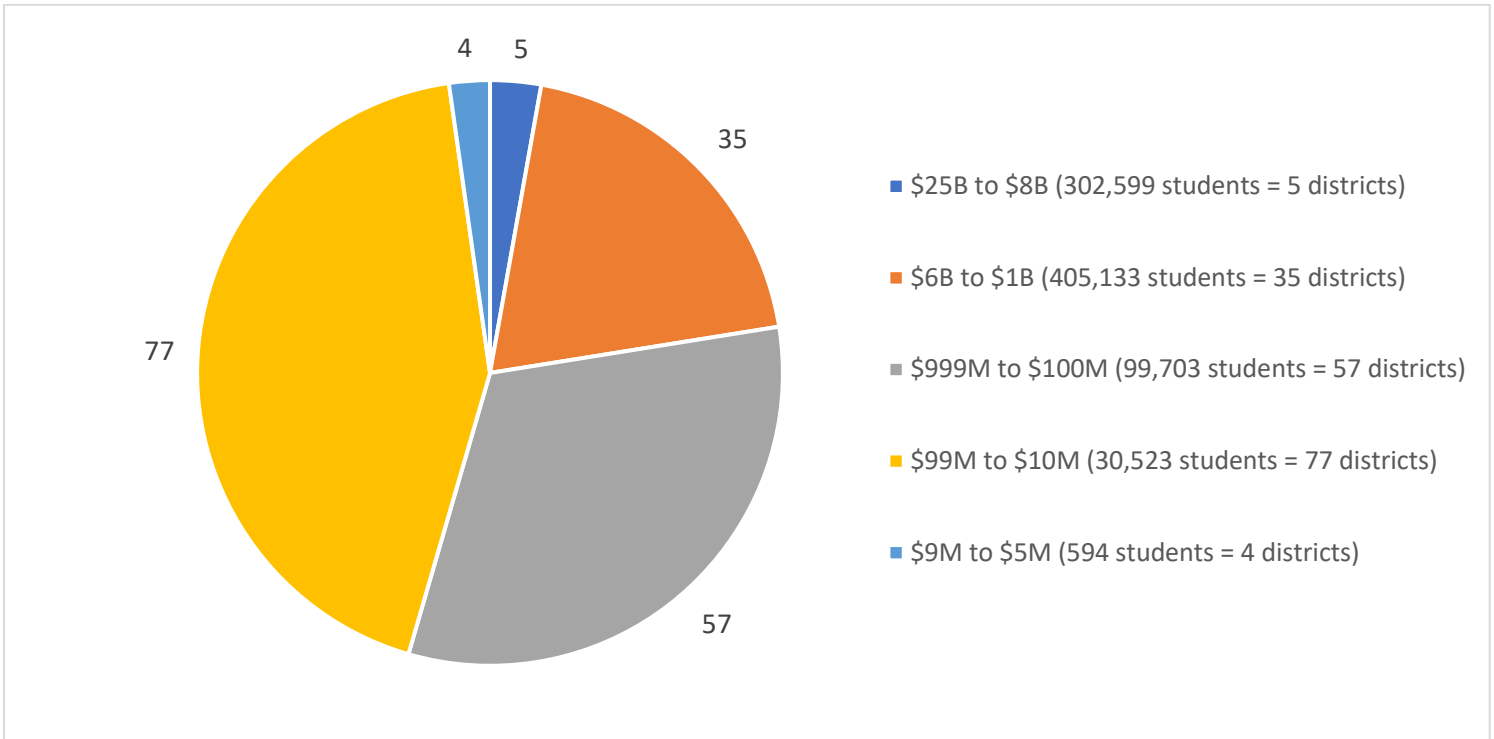


School Districts Total Assessed Value (AV) FY2023-2024
