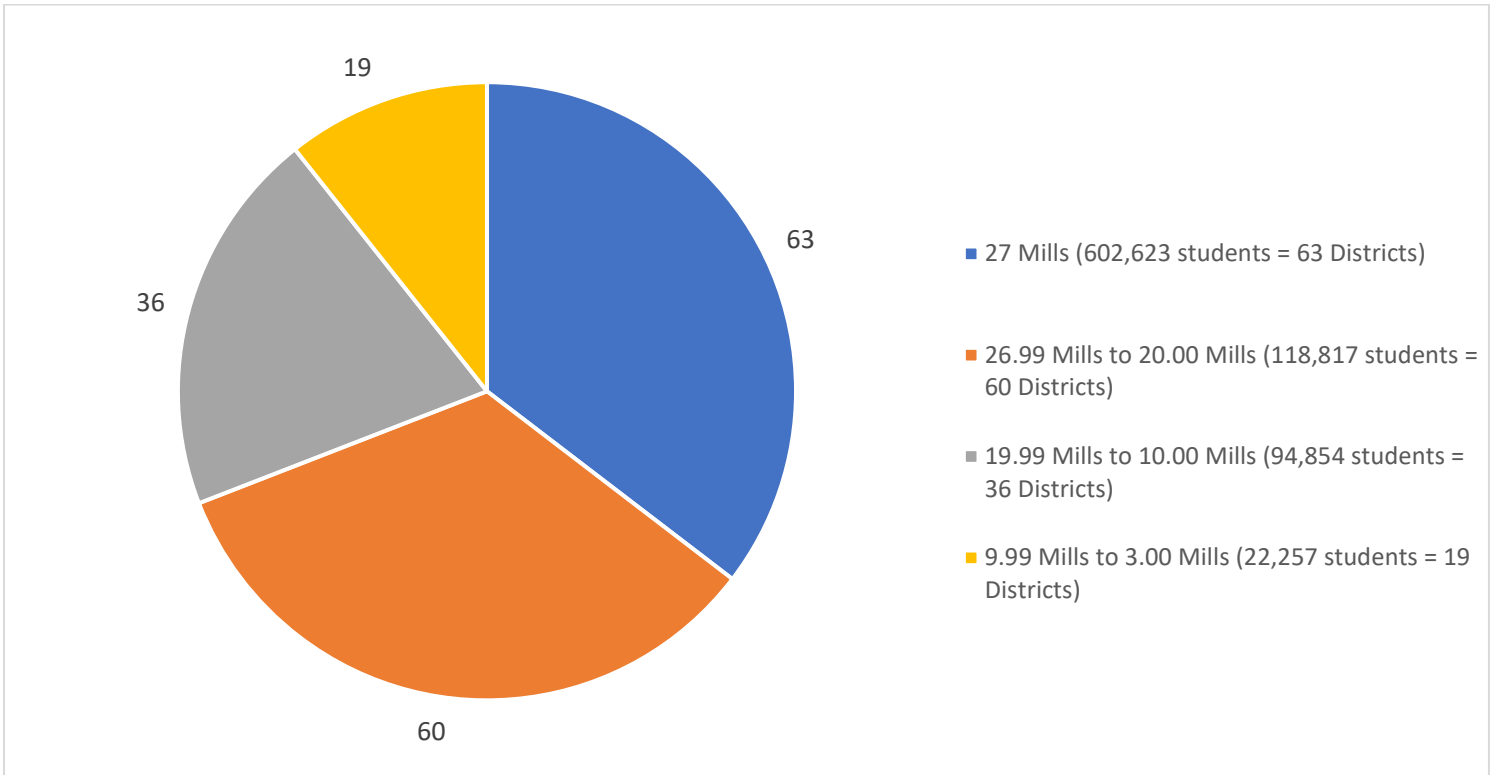


School Districts Total Program Mills FY 2023-24
