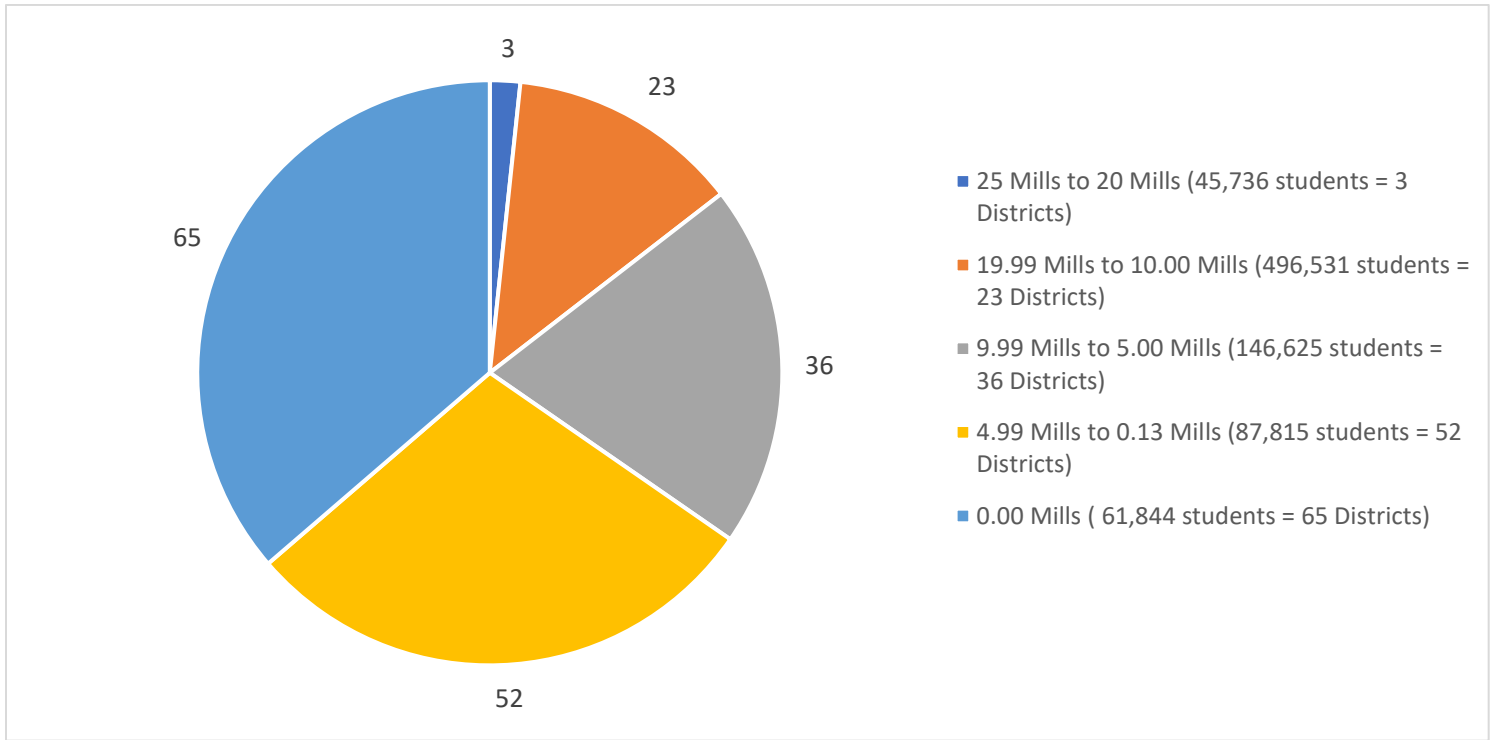


Number of Districts with Voter Approved Mill Levy Overrides FY 2023-24
