3. How often will attendance be taken, every class period, every day, certain months?
4. Is it an average for the year? For the month? The week?
5. How is it reconciled?
6. How will this impact communities with high need populations?
7. What happens if a student is late to class?
8. What are the costs for the district to implement?
9. How does this align with other policies regarding accreditation, accountability and inspiring students to attend school?
10. What is the audit process?
