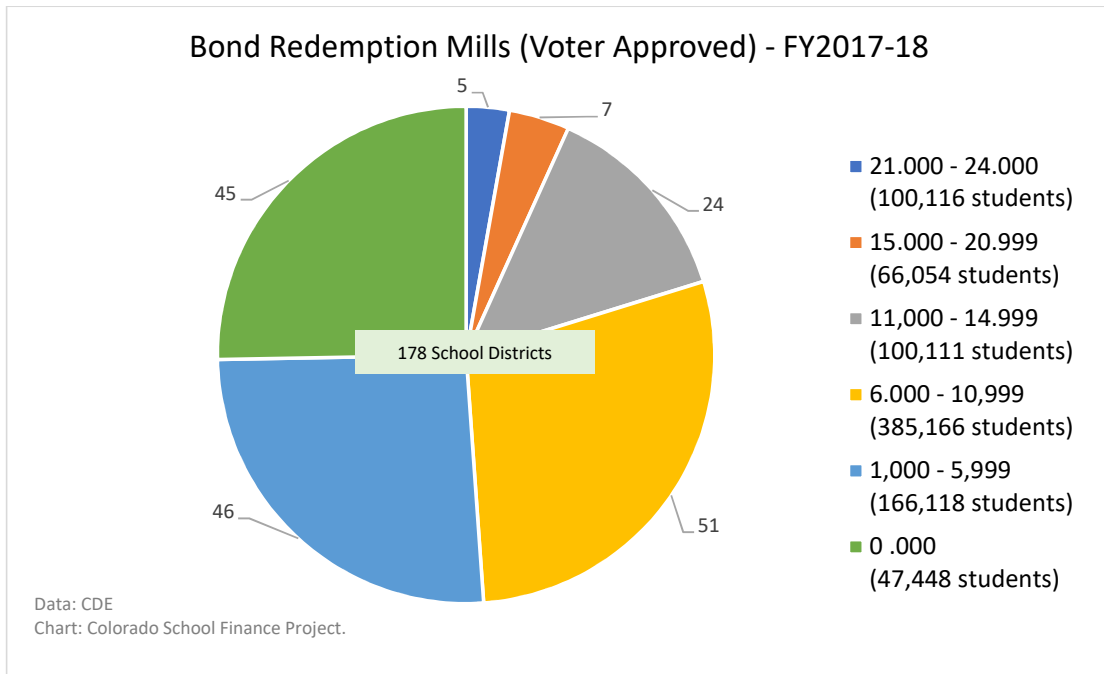


### Bond Redemption Mills (Voter Approved) - FY 2017-18

Bond Mills reflect the number of districts that have passed elections and the number of mills assessed, thus reflecting the variance across the state.

133 districts have a passed a bond, 45 have no bond.

Bond funds can only be spent on capital projects (buildings, roofs, etc.)

School districts have no control over what 1 mill can raise.
