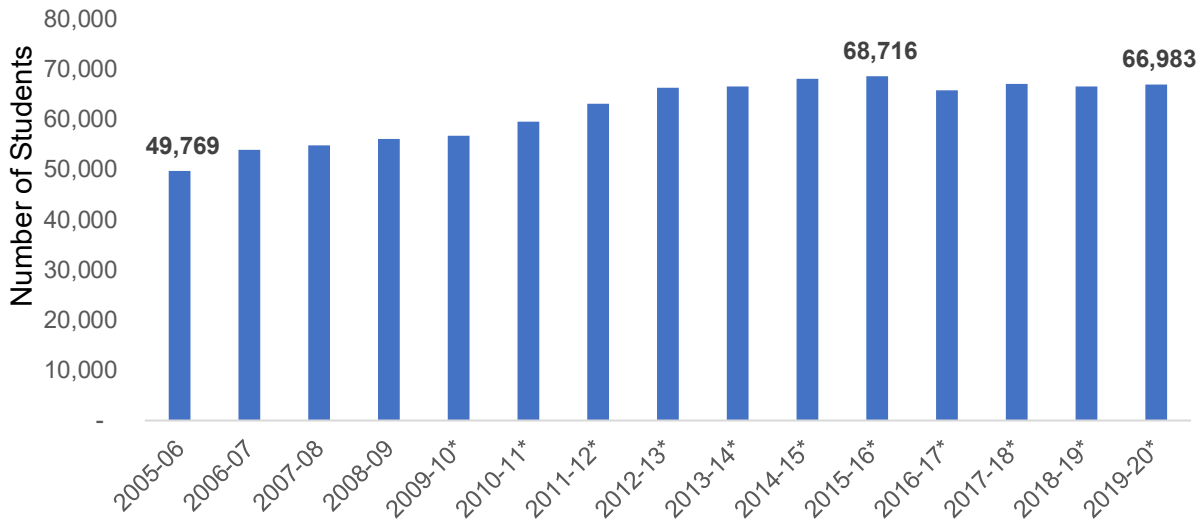


Gifted Education Students: A Look at Student Count and Supplemental Funding

2006-2020**

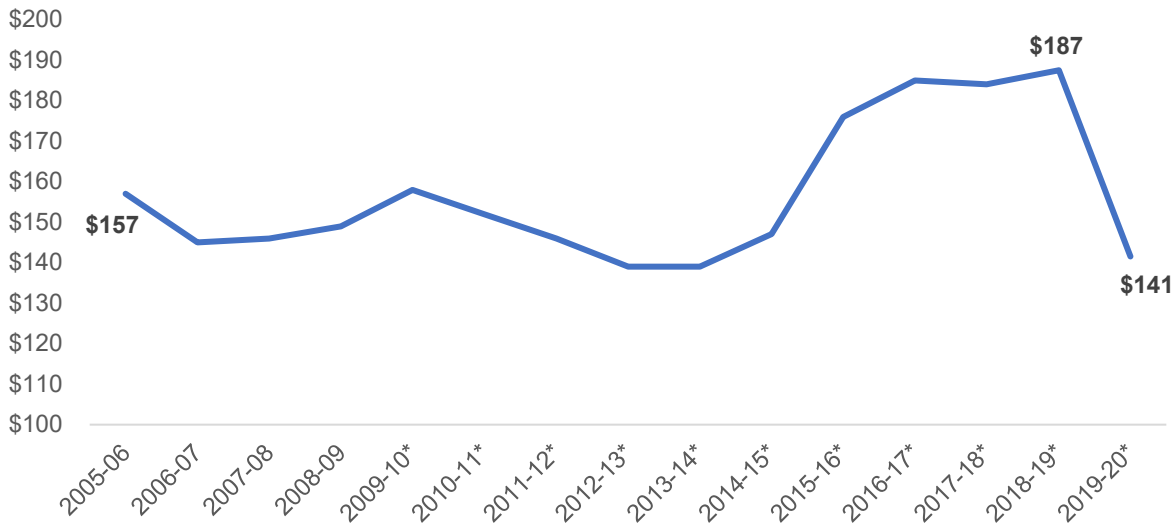

As Colorado’s PK-12 student population grew by more than 24,000 students between 2015-16 and 2019-20, the number of students in Gifted education programs declined by more than 1,500 students. About 7% of Colorado’s students qualify for gifted education services. The graph below illustrates how funding for gifted students has fluctuated for the past 15 years.
