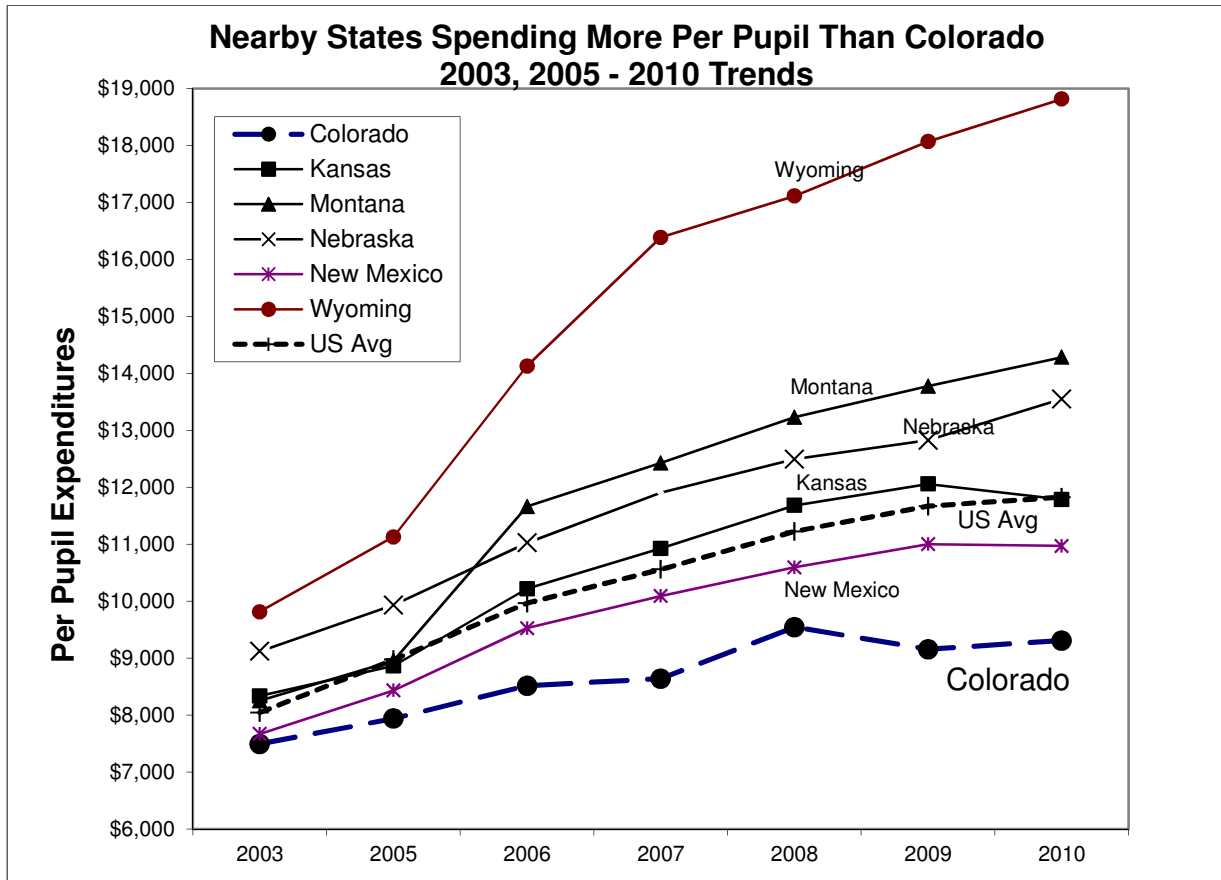


Education Week: Quality Counts 2013 – How Much More Per Pupil?
