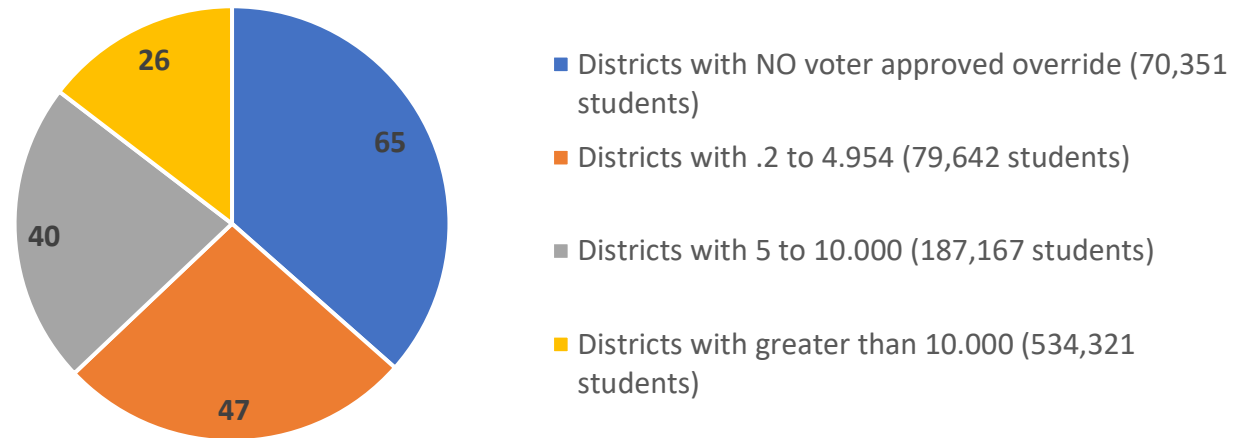

A look at Voter Approved Overrides by Assessed Valuation per funded pupil

Number of Districts by Voter Approved Mill Overriders FY 2020-21



Findings:

- 37 percent of all school districts do not have any voter approved overrides (65 school districts)
 - o Those districts represent 8.1 percent of the students in the state
- 63 percent of all school districts have less than 5.000 voter approved mills (112 school districts)
 - o Those districts represent 17.2 percent of the students in the state
- 37 percent of all school district have more than 5.000 voter approved mills (66 school districts)
 - o Those districts represent 82.8 percent of the students in the state

The following table shows school districts ranked by the number of voter approved mills then by the assessed valuation per funded student (bold column).
