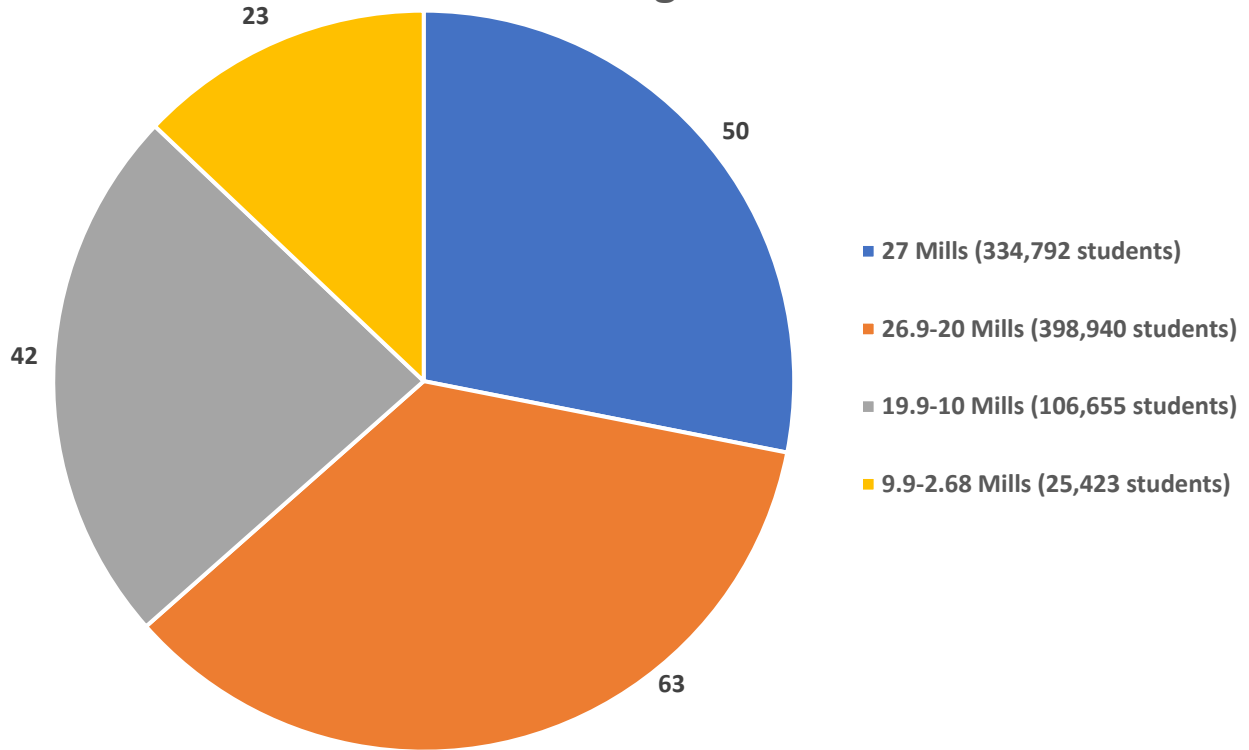


### School Districts Total Program Mills FY 2021-22
