**Summary:**

1. The number of teachers in Colorado has increased, Colorado continues to have fewer teachers per 1,000 students than the national average.
2. Over this 17 year period, Colorado has gone from having over 3.0 more teachers per 1,000 students than the national average to having 3.2 less teachers per 1,000 students.
