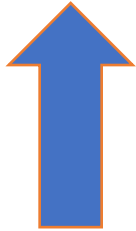


## At-a-Glance: 2019-20 Colorado Public School Student Enrollment



Overall, student enrollment in preschool through 12<sup>th</sup> grade increased by 0.2 percent to 913,223 public school students.



District 49 in El Paso County and School District 27J saw the largest growth 6.7% and 2.9%, respectively. (Excluding districts less than 100 students)



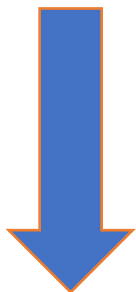
A total of 93 districts and BOCES saw enrollment decreases- 19 districts decreased by 50 or more students, and 13 had decreases of more than 100 students.



Students eligible for free and reduced-price lunch increased by 0.1 percent for total of 371,804 students, or 40.7 percent of students.

Students receiving special education services increased by 0.4 percent for a total of 106,238 students, or 11.6 percent of students.

Students identified as gifted and talented increased by 7.3 percent for a total of 66,983 students, or 7.3 percent of students.



Students identified as English Language learners (those receiving services or being monitored after being exited from an English learner program) decreased by 0.5 percent to 123,248 students.
