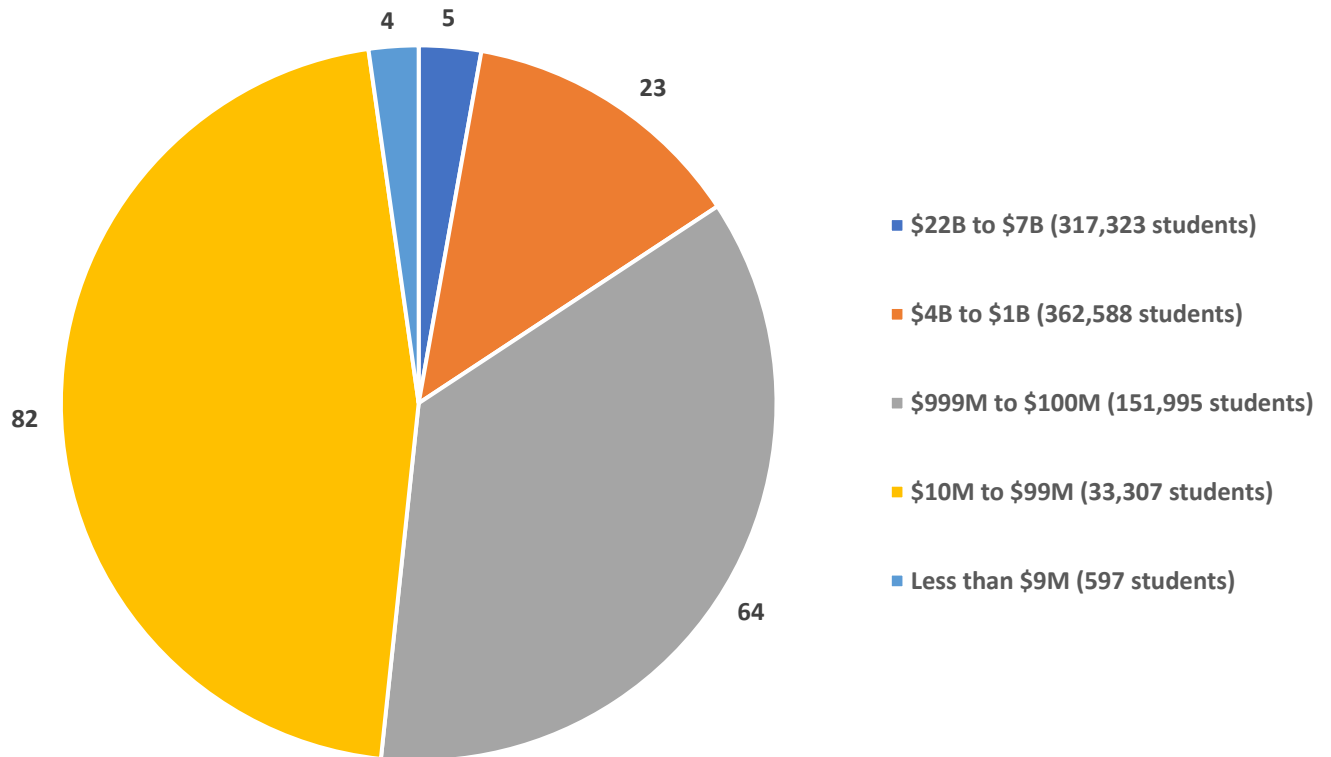


## School Districts Total Assessed Value (AV) FY2021-22
