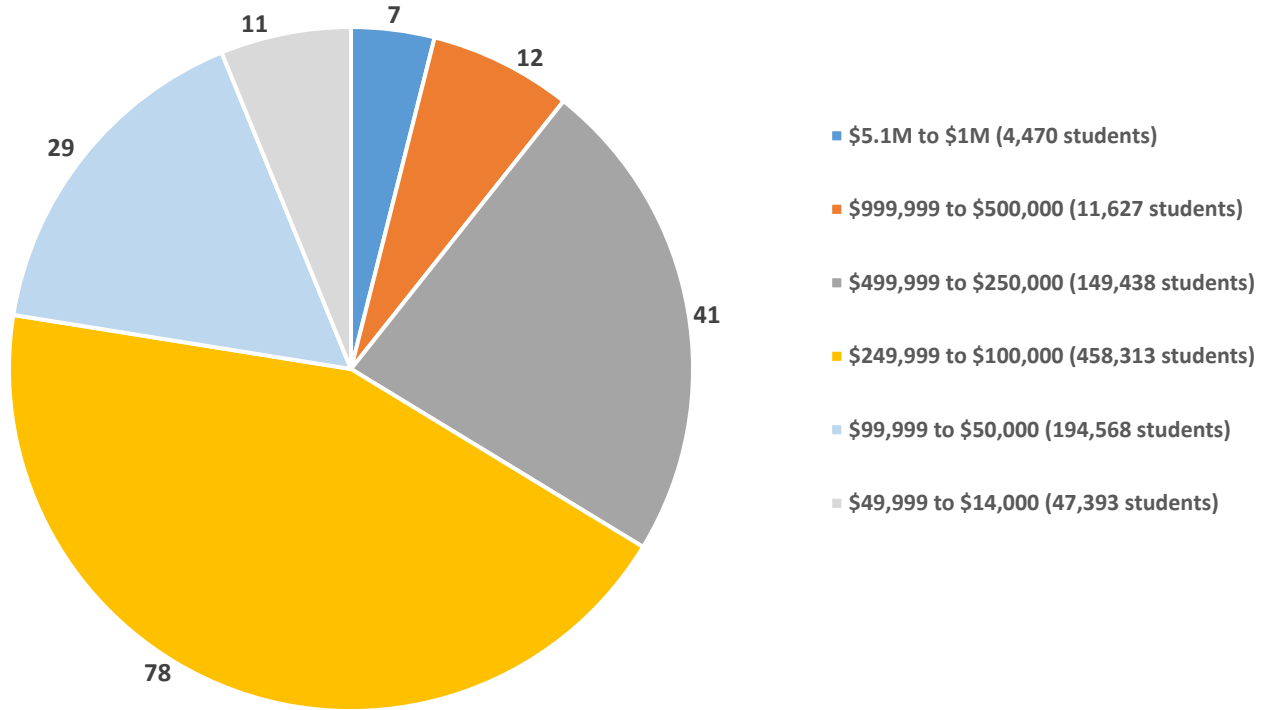


## School Districts' Assessed Value Per Pupil FY 2021-22
