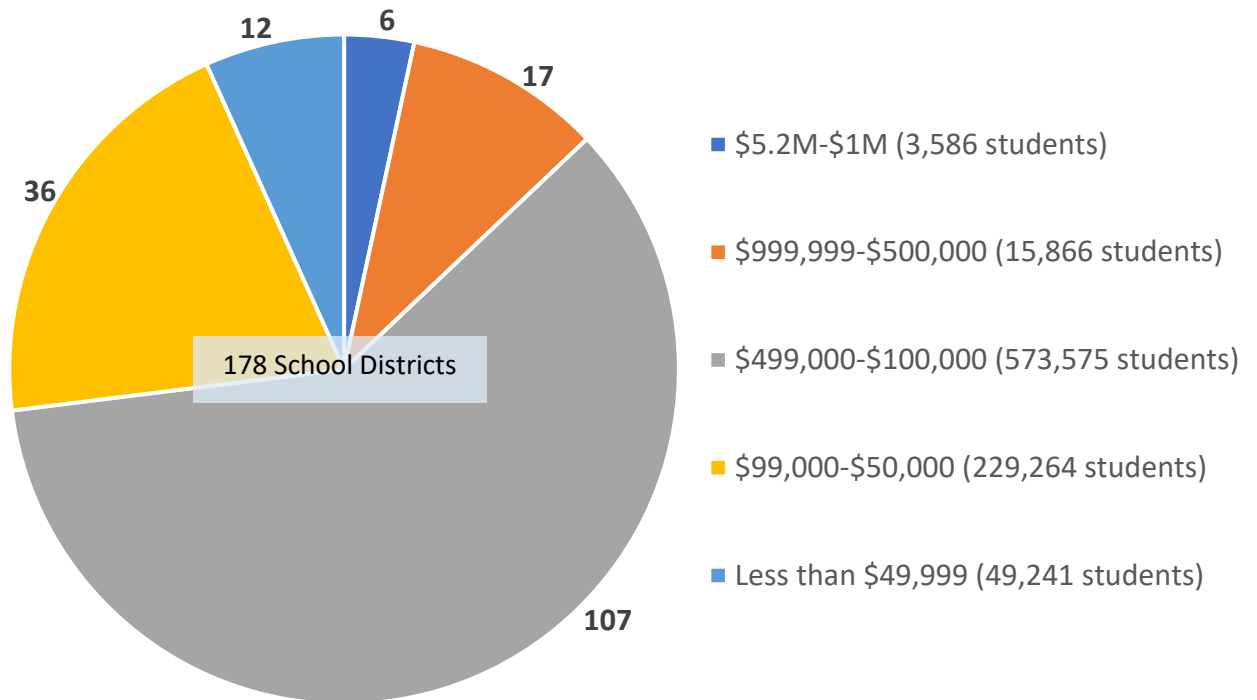


School District's Assessed Value Per Pupil FY2020-21
