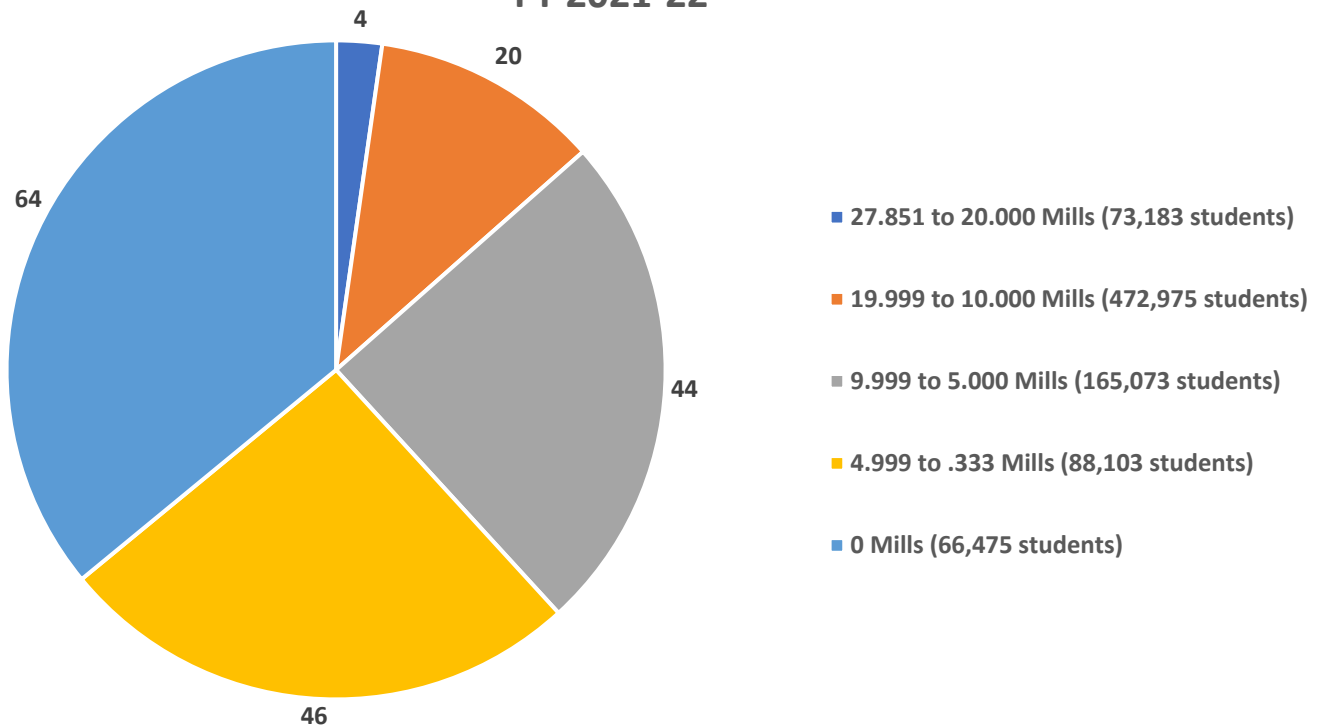


## Number of Districts with Voter Approved Mill Levy Overrides FY 2021-22



A list of districts with voter-approved Override Mills in rank order is on the following pages.

Override Mills show the number of districts that have had successful elections and the number of mills assessed. The rank order reflects the variance of mills across the state.

In Colorado, 114 districts representing 799,334 students have override mills. There are 64 districts representing 66,475 have no override mills.

School districts have no control over what 1 Mill in a school district can raise. The district range for 1 Mill is \$6,044 to \$22,638,161.
