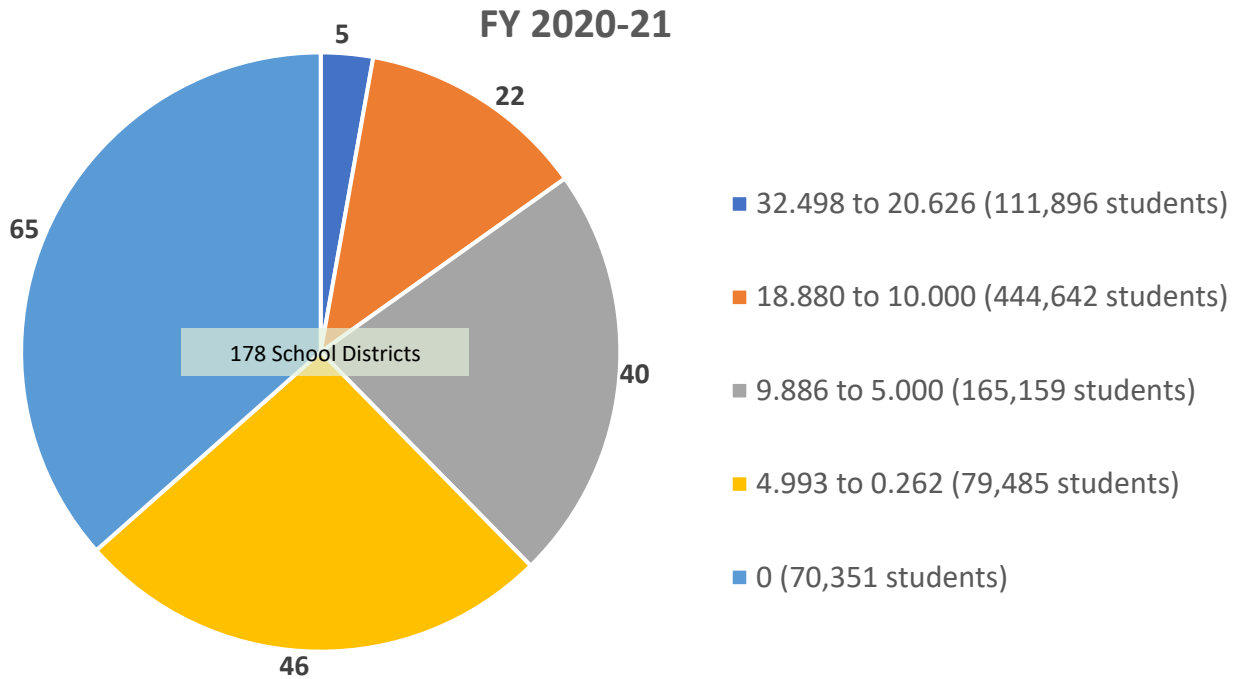


## Number of Districts with Voter-Approved Mill Override



A list of districts with voter-approved Override Mills in rank order is on the following pages.

Override Mills show the number of districts that have had successful elections and the number of mills assessed. The rank order reflects the variance of mills across the state.

In Colorado, 114 districts representing 801,181 students have override mills. There are 64 districts representing 70,351 have no override mills.

School districts have no control over what 1 Mill in a school district can raise. The district range for 1 Mill is \$6,044 to \$21,091,522.
